ROC DES ANGES - IGLESIA VELLA 2023  
IGP COTES CATALANES

Iglesia Vella 2023, named after a long-lost church overlooking the parcel, is crafted from a massal selection of Grenache Gris wines planted in 1954, replanted on the north-facing slopes of Força Réal. Here, shallow, silica-rich schist and high-altitude exposure shape a wine of quiet depth and precision. The vines are farmed biodynamically, with low yields and natural fermentation in large oak.

The nose is poised and stony, opening with white pear, citrus zest, and fennel pollen. The palate is sleek and mineral, driven by bright acidity and a gentle saline thread. Its texture is fine yet mouthwatering, unfolding gradually toward a long, crystalline finish.

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**REGION :** Pyrénées Orientales

**GROWING AREA:** IGP Côtes Catalanes, Village of Montner

**FARMING :** Organic & Biodynamic certified

**SOILS :** Shallow topsoils of ancient schist, rich in silica. North-facing slope of Força Réal, near the village of Montner

**VARIETIES :** Grenache Gris (Massal selection from old vines)

**YIELD :** 15hl/ ha

**VINE AGE:** 15 years

**HARVEST :** First 2 weeks of August 2023

**FERMENTATION & ÉLEVAGE:** Fermentation with indigenous yeasts, elevage in a 15hl foudre

**ALCOHOL:** 12 %
